WINDOWS XP Workstation Settings

DWD recently learned that some of the ASSET users were upgraded to Windows XP and were having problems discerning which radio buttons were selected once they were 'inactivated' or 'locked'.

These types of radio buttons are used in ASSET and we inactivate these fields when we want to lock them to ensure they are not changed in the future. An example of this can be found on the Youth Skill Attainment page for the Performance Related Goal options.

After testing we found that changing the properties of the Display on these computers rectifies this situation.

Any workstation that is running Windows XP, DWD recommends the following;

- 1) Right Click on the desktop and select 'Properties'.
- 2) Click on the 'Appearance' tab.
- 3) Change the 'Windows and Buttons' from Windows XP style to Windows Classic Style.
