Announcing WIFrontDoorHousing

TWO 8-1/2x11" FLIERS AVAILABLE

Low- and moderate-income persons looking for affordable housing can access thousands of free listings at www.wifrontdoorhousing.org.

This Department of Commerce-sponsored web site was the subject of a Wisconsin Job Center Roundtable session in November, 2004. Commerce has now developed two 8-1/2x11" fliers (attachment 1, attachment 2) to promote use of the site.

The WIFrontDoorHousing website provides a statewide directory of affordable public and private housing units available for low- to moderate-income households. The database has on-screen search locators. It simplifies the housing search process by offering prospective tenants free access to rental information.

The Commerce Bureau of Housing, with financial support from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA), developed the site.

Property owners and managers can sign up for a free account and list available affordable units. Housing providers can post vacancies, remove leased units, list property amenities, post photographs and rental agreements, and more.
