On March 31, the Old ITA Website (<http://www.dwd.state.wi.us/dws/ita>) will be pulled from production. It has been replaced by the New ITA System, and will be archived. A "redirect" page will be added point former users to the New ITA System.

Beginning March 31, Wisconsin's Statewide List of Eligible Training Providers will officially switch to the New ITA System (<http://www.wisconsinjobcenter.org/ita>). All current information regarding eligible training programs in Wisconsin will be maintained exclusively on the New ITA System. The New ITA System is already fully operational and may be used now.

The penultimate step for this phase-out of the Old ITA Website occurred on March 3, 2006. That is when New ITA System records were successfully linked to ASSET in the ASSET 2.6.4 release. ASSET now uses the new system to display items from the Statewide List. It had previously used the old.

[FYI: In ASSET, when a case manager selects an ITA Program ID, the ITAProgramProviderLookup table has a Detailed Info link that opens to the appropriate page in the New ITA System.]
