# ITA List Message:

## Demo version of the New ITA Home Page

---

A demonstration version of the New ITA Home Page is now available for review.

### IMPORTANT NOTE!

The data contained in this demonstration version is TEST DATA ONLY. It is not live data. Some information may appear familiar, and in some cases was captured from the present Statewide List. Other data may appear appended or otherwise abbreviated. Please, don't be concerned about the integrity of the TEST DATA at this stage of development.

### ALSO NOTE!

The amount of test data presently in the system is limited. Very few locations, schools, and training programs appear among the test data. Given these limits, the purpose behind sharing the New ITA Home Page for review at this time is to give you early familiarity with the new, enhanced tool set.

The New ITA Home Page allows three kinds of searches:

- \* Keyword search of the program name and description, similar to the present system.
- \* Search by cities where training is offered, from an alphabetical list.
- \* Search by the name of the training provider, from an alphabetical list.

**[Suggestion:** To see the current maximum-available results, search "By Location" and enter the letter 'e' as your criteria. --mww]

At the time it is officially launched, this new public-facing web site will replace the present search page for Wisconsin's Statewide List of Eligible Training Programs. This is the place case managers and training-seeking customers use the most.

The official launch date for these systems has not been established, but the time frame for the official launch will be between now and May 31.
