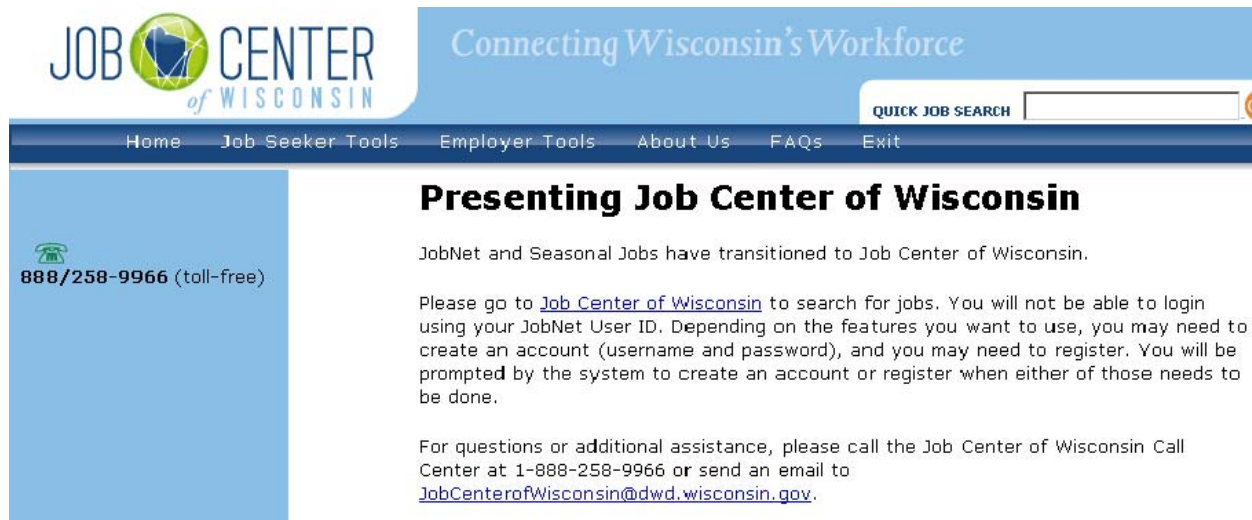

JobNet 3.0 and Seasonal Jobs to be Redirected

Tonight JobNet 3.0 and Seasonal Jobs will be redirected to [Job Center of Wisconsin](#). Customers will no longer be able to access JobNet 3.0 or Seasonal Jobs, even if they know the URL. The redirect message that customers will see if they enter the JobNet 3.0 or Seasonal Jobs URL is:

Job seekers with a JobNet 3.0 User ID will not be able to use it with the Job Center of Wisconsin site. Resource Room staff, JCW Job Seeker Call Center staff, and DWD Service Desk staff should anticipate questions from customers about it. Depending on which features the customer wants to use, he or she may need to create an account, and a registration:

- Job seekers can use the 'Job Search' feature **anonymously**, meaning that they are not required to have an account or registration.
- An **account** (username and password) is required the job seeker wants to use the 'Save Favorite Job Searches' feature.
- A **registration** (an account plus some additional information) is required if the job seeker wants to use the 'My Résumé/Work Application' feature.
 - The smoothest path for registration is to have the job seeker click on 'Job Seeker Tools' and then choose either 'My Resume', 'My Work Application', 'Register for Services/Update', or 'Register for Veteran Services'. The system will take the customer through the account creation process, then directly through the Title 3 registration process.
