Job Seeker Résumé/Work Application Inactivation Begins

Beginning last night, JCW resumes will be inactivated for job seekers who have not logged into JCW during the last 90 days. Please see '[60 Day Warning Emails Begin](#)'.

The job seeker's résumé/work application data has been changed from 'Pending Expired' to 'Expired'. No email is sent to the job seeker.

The job seeker can reactivate his 'Expired' résumé/work application by checking the checkbox for the expired résumé/work application data and clicking on the View/Update button. The job seeker will go to the 'Resume Expired' page and see two questions:

- **“Your résumé/work application has expired. Do you want to reactivate your résumé/work application?”**
 - If 'yes', the résumé/work application is reactivated. A second question appears - **“Do you want Employers to match you to their jobs?”**
 - If 'no', the résumé/work application will remain expired.

An expired resume can be reactivated for up to 25 months. After that, the résumé/work application will be purged from the system.
