JobNet Business Education URL

It's here! Time to check out the new, improved JobNet Business! An exact duplicate of JobNet Business is available for you to try.

To access the education version of JobNet Business, please do **one** of the following:

1. If you have do **not** have any internet applications open, please click on this link <https://education.dwd.state.wi.us/jobnetbusiness/staff>.
2. If you do have any internet applications open, please copy and paste this URL <https://education.dwd.state.wi.us/jobnetbusiness/staff> into the Address line of your browser and click on the Go button.

When the Enter Network Password text box pops up, log in using the same Username and Password that you currently use for the Employer Record System (ERS) and/or the Wisconsin Job Order System (WJOS). It may take a few seconds for the site to load.

There are two levels of access - Employer Management and Job Order Management. The features shown on the menu tree will be determined by the level of access you have. If you currently have ERS View or Update access, you now have Employer Management access in JobNet Business. If you currently have ERS/WJOS access, you now have Job Order Management access in JobNet Business.

Any user can now view and update any employer record anywhere in the state. **This is a change from ERS.**

Please go to the above URL and play around with the system features. You can't harm anything - this is the education version of the system.

The JobNet Business System Manual is not yet available, so if you click on the HELP link you will not find anything.

We are in the final stages of completing the training videos for distribution. Look for more information on that in the next several days.
