JobNet Business-Employer Education Environment Available for Practice

We have had some inquiries about what the employer side of JobNet Business looks like and how it works. Using the steps below you can create a fake employer record in the education environment, and then create an employer login Username and Password. This will give you some hands-on experience with the employer side of JobNet Business.

Be sure to only use the education environment - not the production (real) sites!

1. Go to <https://www.dwd.state.wi.us/accountmanagement/AccountCreationOverview.aspx> to create an Active Directory Account ID for a fake company.
2. Go to <https://education.dwd.state.wi.us/jobnetbusiness> and complete the Account Creation process.
3. Go to <https://education.dwd.state.wi.us/jobnetbusiness/staff> to (1) create a Profile and a Site for the fake company, and (2) approve the employer registration (you will login as yourself to approve the employer registration).
4. Go back to to <https://education.dwd.state.wi.us/jobnetbusiness> and login as the employer.
