JobNet Business Problems Fixed

The following changes were implemented last night:

- On a staff job order the "Last Contact" field will only be displayed if the job order is "ON JOBNET", "OFF JOBNET MAY REOPEN", or "OFF JOBNET NO REOPEN". The Last Contact date will be cleared when the job order is copied. A "Set as Today" button was added.
- The "Last Contact Date" field is not displayed on an employer job order, but if the employer copies a job order this field will now be cleared on the staff side. If an "ON JOBNET" job order is updated by an employer the "Last Contact Date" field will now be updated with the current date. Updating the Last Contact Date field on a job order places the order at the top of the list that is returned when job seekers search JobNet.

Updating the Last Contact Date when the employer updates an order should help those staff who have employers who frequently close orders and put new, almost duplicate orders on, so that their orders appear near the top of the list when job seekers search JobNet.

- The Employer Updates page was modified to display 20 records per page in each grid. The Manage Employer Updates page was modified to give the ability for users to filter updated Company and Contact records by County.
- In staff JobNet Business the issue with the Contact search failing on an Account ID search and an Exact Match Site Trade Name search have been resolved.
- On the Job Order Details tab the typo in "If Other Non-Standard Explain" is corrected.
- The problem with the text in the Non-Standard Explain fields for Shift and Work Days not showing up in Preview mode and on JobNet has been fixed.
- The Order Taker and Order Responsible Staff fields now update on a copied job order.
- The problem with Add Multiple Activities (if trying to add activities to more than five employers) has been fixed.

- The Staff Referral and Self Referral Counts now clear and reset to zero on a copied job order.
- The Security message box that popped up when clicking on the Preview or Email Preview buttons no longer pops up.
