

JobNet Business Changes

The following changes were implemented last night:

- When a job order is copied the site information will now be copied from the site record instead of the job order. This addresses the issues that users encountered in not being able to copy "OFF JOBNET NO REOPEN" job orders that are missing site information.
- If you select 'None' for Education and Training on a job order, and have comments in the Education/ Training text field, only the comments appear on JobNet and in the Preview mode.
- System error problem fixed :
 - o Other Benefits checkbox
 - o Application Instructions Other checkbox
 - o Work Days Non-Standard Explain checkbox
 - o Shifts Non-Standard Explain checkbox
- The entire Staff Order Responsible email address will be displayed.
- The following pages in Staff JobNet Business will now allow HTML text in all fields on all tabs:
 - o Profile
 - o Site
 - o Job Order

The spellchecker will be modified to ignore these html tags with the next round of system fixes.

- The following pages in Employer JobNet Business will now allow HTML text in all fields on all tabs:
 - o Site
 - o Job Order
- On both the Staff and Employer sides users will not be able to modify the Job Order Removal Date until the job order is in 'On JobNet' status.
- Staff may now select 'Full-time/Part-time Temporary' for the Workweek. There was a bug that was not allowing this option to be selected.
- When an employer saves changes to a job order that is in On JobNet status, the Last Contact date field is updated with the current date. The Last Contact date update will not appear on the staff person's Employer Update page. (Fewer things for you to look at!)
- The problem with the Delete button not functioning if the job order has job order hits recorded has been fixed.
