GOVERNOR PRESENTS \$100,000 CHECK TO RACINE AREA MANUFACTURERS AND COMMERCE

Governor Jim Doyle presented President Roger Caron of the Racine Area Manufacturers and Commerce (RAMAC) with \$100,000 on Tuesday June 6th. The funds, awarded by the Governor's Council on Workforce Investment (CWI), will be used by RAMAC to increase the efficiency and productivity of workers and workplaces in Southeast Wisconsin. SECRETARY GASSMAN CELEBRATES MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE

On June 1, 2006, Wisconsin's minimum wage for adults increased from \$5.70 per hour to \$6.50 per hour. Secretary Gassman went to four cities in the state to celebrate. An estimated 200,000 low-wage workers will benefit from this increase and an increase in 2005. Raising the minimum wage was a goal that Governor Jim Doyle set as part of his Grow Wisconsin initiative. Prior to these raises, the minimum wage had been unchanged since 1997. UPDATED EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION NEEDED

Employees are encouraged to review and update emergency contact information on a regular basis. Staff can review and edit information (after this story is gone) by clicking on the [HRS info](#) link in the page header, then on the "Emergency Info" tab. The "Emergency Info" page also has options for listing allergies, medical conditions or other personal health information that could be helpful in a health crisis. This information is password-protected, and accessible only to the supervisor and a limited number of administrators in the department as needed for human resource management or health & safety reasons.
