Job Orders Now Transferred from JobCentral!


Jobnet's 'Enhanced Job Search' has been modified to display job orders downloaded from the JobCentral site. This change was made to help Federal Contractor employers meet job listing regulations.

Employers may also have job orders from their website indexed (uploaded electronically) **FREE OF CHARGE** to JobCentral. Job orders will then be transferred nightly JobCentral to JobNet. This will be a tremendous improvement for those large employers who are not able to enter their job orders directly into JobNet due to workload.

Changes you will see in JobNet (Enhanced search):

- A Quality-Checked checkmark icon appears next to those job orders entered through JobNet Business and approved by job center staff. This lets the jobseeker know that these job orders have been checked for quality.

When a jobseeker clicks the link for a JobCentral job order, the job order details will be displayed in a new window displaying the information either on the JobCentral site or the employer's web site. Jobseekers will be notified that they are leaving JobNet, as shown below:
