Smoother Registration Path Restored in Job Center of Wisconsin

Yesterday we discovered that the smoother registration path in Job Center of Wisconsin (JCW) was not working for job seekers. It was fixed earlier this morning.

When a job seeker clicks on Register for Services/Update or Create/Update Résumé, he/she is prompted to login or set up an account. When the job seeker clicks on 'Set up an account' they are taken to the Account Creation screens to set up an Active Directory account. After the account has been successfully created and the job seeker clicks the 'Done' button, the system logs the job seeker in automatically and takes him/her to the Title 3 registration pages. After successfully completing the Title 3 registration, the job seeker is taken to the Job Seeker homepage in JCW (if Register for Services/Update was originally selected) or to Step 1 of the resume (if Create/Update Résumé was originally selected).
